Jean Redpath In Concert for AIDS West

A singer of international renown, Jean was born in Edinburgh. At the age of 24 she went to the US and her singing career took off in Greenwich Village where she sang with such famous names as Rambling Jack Elliott and Bob Dylan. She has toured the US, Canada, Hong Kong and Australia with her repertoire of songs and has sung in the Sydney Opera House. She has been awarded many honours for her work including an MBE in 1987. For this concert she will perform with The Chorale from Illinois, USA, many of her best loved songs in a programme of Celtic traditional music and popular choral classics.
